E-Health and Telemedicine

- Electronic healthcare system is the information and telecommunication system that ensures automatization of healthcare services recording and management of medical information.
 - Is an element of e-Government
 - Shall apply to perform the program of the state financial guarantees of health care (state benefits package)
- Telemedicine is the set of measures and technologies applied in the course of the provision of health care with the use of distance communication means in the form of electronic information sharing
 - May be an element of e-Goverment
 - Shall be a service paid by a patient

Legal Regulation of Telemedicine in Poland and Ukraine: the common features

- Legally introduced in 2015
- May be provided by a licensed provider
- Special focus on rural medicine
- Was not well-developed prior to the COVID-19 pandemic
- Acceleration due to COVID-19. E-referrals, e-receipts, etc.
- Care about patients with COVID-19 by GPs via distance communication means is allowed

Legal Regulation of Telemedicine in Poland and Ukraine: the common features and differences

Ukraine:

- Aimed at providing telemedical consultations within the "Doctor – Doctor(s) format" rather at "home (household) telemedicine" within the "Patient-Doctor" format
 - Little regulation of the "Patient-Doctor" format tools

Telemedicine and COVID-19: Issues and Solutions

- Licensing and provision of telemedical services
- Special platform
- Personal data protection
- Integrity of data
- Explanation of limitation and fixation of it
- Informed consent
- Recording of the services provided via the tools of Telemedicine
- Medical activity (type of medical services) that can be provided via the tools of Telemedicine
- Legal Liability

Legal Solutions

- Legislative
- Using existing legal tools
 - International crossfertilization



E-Health and Telemedicine: Directions for Further Research (A Few Examples)

- National Policy (Strategy) of E-Health Development: Responsiveness to the new challenges
- Human Rights, E-Health and Telemedicine: The pressing issues
